By Mr. Eldredge of Chatham, petition of Charles E. Frazier, Jr., and Lawrence R. Gardiner that the Department of Public Works be authorized to enlarge the channel and basin in Wellfleet Harbor by dredging the same to a depth of ten feet at mean low water. Harbors and Public Lands.

AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE IMPROVEMENT OF THE CHANNEL AND BASIN IN WELFLEET HARBOR BY DREDGING THE SAME TO A DEPTH OF TEN FEET AT MEAN LOW WATER.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The department of public works is
2 hereby authorized and directed to dredge a channel
3 of adequate width, with suitable turning basin in the
4 vicinity of the town landing in the harbor of Wellfleet,
5 to a depth of ten feet at mean low water.

1 SECTION 2. For the purpose aforesaid the depart-
2 ment may expend sums not exceeding in the aggregate
3 dollars as may be hereafter appropri-
4 ated therefor together with any funds which may be
5 allocated by the federal government or from any other
6 source for said purpose.
