AN ACT PROVIDING THAT TEMPORARY EMPLOYEES OF THE METROPOLITAN DISTRICT COMMISSION BE EXCUSED FROM DUTY ON LEGAL HOLIDAYS WITHOUT LOSS OF COMPENSATION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter ninety-two of the General Laws is hereby
2 amended by inserting after section sixty-five, as ap-
3 pearing in the Tercentenary Edition, the following
4 new section:—

5 *Section 65A.* Every temporary employee of the
6 metropolitan district commission shall be excused
7 from duty on legal holidays without loss of compen-
8 sation.
