AN ACT REQUIRING RECORDS OF DEATH OF WAR VETERANS
TO SPECIFY THE WAR IN WHICH SUCH VETERANS
SERVED.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The third paragraph of section one of chapter forty-
2 six of the General Laws, as appearing in the Ter-
3 centenary Edition, is hereby amended by adding at
4 the end the following sentence:—

5 If deceased shall have served in the army, navy or
6 marine corps of the United States in war in which it
7 has been engaged a recital to that effect specifying the
8 war.
