AN ACT RELATIVE TO REQUISITIONS FOR THE EMPLOYMENT OF LABORERS UNDER THE CIVIL SERVICE LAW.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Whenever the director or head of a department of
2 any city or town which is subject to or has accepted
3 the labor classification under civil service shall make
4 a requisition to the division of civil service for a list
5 from which to appoint, such requisition shall be ac-
6 companied by an affidavit of the director or head of
7 such department that there is money available to pay
8 such employee or employees at a fixed daily wage for
9 the period of his employment and such requisition
10 shall also be accompanied by an affidavit by the city
11 or town auditor that there is money available to pay
12 such employee or employees at a fixed daily wage for
13 the period of his employment.
