The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Forty-One.

AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR THE DISPOSITION OF CERTAIN SURPLUS REPORTS IN THE DEPARTMENT OF THE SECRETARY OF THE COMMONWEALTH.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The state secretary is hereby authorized to provide
2 for the free distribution of the following documents
3 or reports, notwithstanding the provisions of the
4 special resolves pertaining thereto:— Laws relative
5 to the construction, alteration and maintenance of
6 buildings and other structures in the city of Boston,
7 published under the provisions of chapter thirty-nine
8 of the resolves of nineteen hundred and thirty-eight;
9 report of the special commission on taxation and pub-
10 lic expenditures, published under the provisions of
11 chapter seventy-three of the resolves of nineteen
12 hundred and thirty-eight; and the report of the spe-
13 cial commission to investigate the activities within
14 this commonwealth of communistic, fascist, nazi and
15 other subversive organizations, so called, published
16 under the provisions of chapter eighty-seven of the
17 resolves of nineteen hundred and thirty-eight.
