RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR THE REIMBURSEMENT IN PART OF THE CITY OF BOSTON BY THE COMMONWEALTH FOR EXPENSES INCURRED BY SAID CITY IN THE OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE OF THE SUMNER TUNNEL THEREIN.

1 *Resolved*, That, subject to appropriation, there be  
2 allowed and paid by the commonwealth from the  
3 Highway Fund to the city of Boston the sum of two  
4 hundred thousand dollars, to reimburse said city in  
5 part for expenses incurred by it in the operation and  
6 maintenance of the vehicular tunnel between Boston  
7 proper and East Boston, known as the Sumner tun-  
8 nel, one half of said sum to be paid as aforesaid on  
9 July first in the current year and one half on July  
10 first in the year nineteen hundred and forty-two.
