AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE USE OF WATER RIGHTS IN LAKE  
QUINSIGAMOND AND CERTAIN NEIGHBORING PONDS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 The attorney general is hereby authorized and re-  
2 quested to investigate whether or not the municipali-  
3 ties of Worcester, Shrewsbury and Grafton, or any  
4 of them, or any of the inhabitants thereof, are being  
5 subjected to any unnecessary and intolerable nuisance  
6 by any acts or omissions in the use of water rights  
7 of lake Quinsigamond or Long pond, and Dorety or  
8 Round pond, so called; and if he is satisfied that any  
9 such nuisance exists, he is hereby authorized and re-  
10 quested to properly present the matter to the supreme  
11 judicial court for such relief as said court may be  
12 empowered to give.
