AN ACT CHANGING THE PROVISIONS OF LAW RESPECTING
LICENSE FEES FOR LICENSES TO SELL ALCOHOLIC BEVER-
AGES OR WINES AND MALT BEVERAGES ONLY TO BE
DRUNK ON THE PREMISES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Repre-
sentatives in General Court assembled, and by the
authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section twelve of chapter one hundred and thirty-
2 eight of the General Laws, as amended, is hereby
3 further amended by striking out the fourth para-
4 graph, as appearing in section one of chapter four
5 hundred and sixty-eight of the acts of nineteen hun-
6 dred and thirty-five, and inserting in place thereof
7 the following:—

8 License fees for all classes of licenses for the sale
9 of all alcoholic beverages or wines and malt bever-
10 ages only shall be determined upon by the alcoholic
11 beverage commission.
