AN ACT TO PROTECT CERTAIN UNEMPLOYMENT BENEFITS  
OF PERSONS IN ARMED FORCES OF THE UNITED STATES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section sixteen of chapter one hundred  
2 and fifty-one A of the General Laws, as appearing in  
3 chapter four hundred and twenty-one of the acts of  
4 nineteen hundred and thirty-seven, is hereby further  
5 amended by adding at the end the following new sub-  
6 section: —

7 (g) Wage credits of any person shall not cease to  
8 be available for the payment of unemployment com-  
9 pensation by reason of lapse of time occasioned by  
10 military service.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 passage.
