AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE REPAIR AND PLACING IN SUITABLE CONDITION FOR PUBLIC TRAVEL OF UNACCEPTED STREETS IN THE CITY OF BROCKTON.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 The city of Brockton, through its highway depart-  
2 ment, water department and engineers' department,  
3 is hereby authorized to repair and place in suitable  
4 condition for public travel streets in said city which  
5 are open for public use, but which have not become  
6 public ways.
