By Mr. Bresnahan of Springfield, petition of Daniel J. Bresnahan relative to limiting the hours of employment in retail food stores and prohibiting work in such stores after six o'clock in the evening. Labor and Industries.

AN ACT LIMITING THE HOURS OF EMPLOYMENT IN RETAIL FOOD STORES AND PROHIBITING WORK IN OR IN CONNECTION WITH SUCH STORES AFTER SIX O'CLOCK IN THE EVENING.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter one hundred and forty-nine of the General
2 Laws is hereby amended by adding after section fifty
3 A, as inserted by section two of chapter four hundred
4 and twenty-three of the acts of nineteen hundred and
5 thirty-five, the following new section: —

6 *Section 50B.* No person shall be employed in or
7 work in connection with a retail food store for more
8 than fifty hours in any one week, nor except in an
9 emergency, after six o'clock post meridian.
