AN ACT PROVIDING THAT NEWSPAPERS MAY BE KEPT ON ANY PUBLIC SIDEWALK IN THE CITY OF BOSTON WITHOUT A PERMIT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Newspapers may be kept on any public sidewalk in
- 2 the city of Boston without a permit notwithstanding
- 3 the fact that they may be classed as merchandise and
- 4 as such would be subject to a law or ordinance requir-
- 5 ing such permit.
