## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

---

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Forty-One.

AN ACT PROVIDING THAT ALLOWANCES UNDER CITY AND TOWN RETIREMENT SYSTEMS BE BASED ON THE HIGHEST SALARY RECEIVED BY THE MEMBER RETIRED.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Those parts of chapter thirty-two of the General  
2 Laws providing for retirement allowances to city and  
3 town employees who are members of retirement sys-  
4 tems are hereby amended by providing that the pen-  
5 sions that form a part thereof shall be based on the  
6 highest earnings of such members instead of their  
7 average earnings.
