By Mr. Eldredge of Chatham, petition of Jesse D. Rogers and others that the Department of Public Works be authorized to erect and maintain a bath house at New Beach in the town of Provincetown. Harbors and Public Lands.

AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE ERECTION AND MAINTENANCE
BY THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS OF A BATH
HOUSE AT NEW BEACH IN PROVINCETOWN.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The department of public works is
2 hereby authorized and directed to construct, maintain
3 and operate a bath house at New Beach, in the town
4 of Provincetown, and may establish and charge a
5 suitable fee for the use of the lockers and facilities
6 of the bath house and of the parking area.

1 SECTION 2. For the purposes outlined in section
2 one, the said department may expend for construction
3 a sum not exceeding sixty thousand dollars.
