AN ACT REQUIRING MOTOR VEHICLES TO BE EQUIPPED WITH KAY-GEE THROTTLE SAFETY DEVICES, SO CALLED.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The fifth sentence of section seven of chapter
2 ninety of the General Laws, as appearing in chapter
3 fifty-one of the acts of nineteen hundred and thirty-
4 three, is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof
5 the following:— and shall be provided with a Kay-
6 Gee throttle safety device, so called, — so as to read
7 as follows:— Every motor vehicle so operated shall
8 be provided with a muffler or other suitable device
9 to prevent unnecessary noise and with a suitable bell,
10 horn or other means of signalling, and with suitable
11 lamps; and automobiles shall be provided with a lock,
12 a key or other device to prevent such vehicle from
13 being set in motion by unauthorized persons, or
14 otherwise, contrary to the will of the owner or person
15 in charge thereof and shall be provided with a Kay-
16 Gee throttle safety device, so called.
