## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Forty-One.

AN ACT PROVIDING THAT EMPLOYEES OF STATE INSTITUTIONS WHO CONTRACT DISEASES IN THE COURSE OF THEIR EMPLOYMENT SHALL BE CONSIDERED AS HAVING SUFFERED INJURY UNDER THE WORKMEN'S COMPENSATION LAW.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Notwithstanding any provision of law inconsistent  
2 herewith, an employee of a state institution who  
3 contracts disease in the course of his employment  
4 shall be considered as having suffered injury under  
5 the workmen's compensation law.
