By Mr. Moran of Somerville, petition of John M. Lynch (mayor), Catherine E. Falvey, Eugene H. Giroux and Walter J. Moran that the city of Somerville be authorized to pay certain bills of the year 1935. Municipal Finance (Joint).

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Forty-One.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF SOMERVILLE TO PAY CERTAIN BILLS OF THE YEAR NINETEEN HUNDRED AND THIRTY-FIVE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The city of Somerville is hereby au-
2 thorized to appropriate money for the payment of
3 unpaid bills of said city included as deferred accounts
4 of nineteen hundred and thirty-five, in the amended
5 report of the auditor of said city, a copy of which is
6 on file in the office of the director of accounts in the
7 department of corporations and taxation.

1 SECTION 2. This appropriation is to be raised by
2 a bond issue of the city of Somerville to be issued by
3 the mayor of said city with the advice and approval
4 of the treasurer and auditor, in an amount not to

5 exceed two hundred and ninety thousand dollars, said
6 bonds to be paid in not more than ten years, provided
7 the same are authorized by a two thirds vote of the
8 board of aldermen of said city.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
