By Mr. Partridge of Watertown, petition of Clark B. Partridge, the board of selectmen and another that the town of Watertown be authorized to use a portion of the money received from the sale of its old town hall site for library purposes. Municipal Finance (Joint).

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF WATERTOWN TO USE A PORTION OF THE MONEY RECEIVED FROM THE SALE OF THE OLD TOWN HALL SITE, TO AN AMOUNT NOT EXCEEDING NINETEEN THOUSAND SEVEN HUNDRED AND FIFTY DOLLARS, FOR REMODELING THE NORTH BRANCH LIBRARY IN SAID TOWN.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The town of Watertown is hereby
2 authorized to use the money received from the sale
3 of the old town hall site, to an amount not exceeding
4 nineteen thousand seven hundred and fifty dollars,
5 for the purpose of remodeling the North Branch library
6 in said town, notwithstanding the provisions of sec-
7 tion sixty-three of chapter forty-four of the General
8 Laws.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
