AN ACT PLACING THE POSITIONS OF MAINTENANCE MEN
IN THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS UNDER THE
CIVIL SERVICE LAWS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section four of chapter thirty-one of
2 the General Laws, as most recently amended by chap-
3 ter forty-nine of the acts of nineteen hundred and
4 forty-one, is hereby further amended by adding at
5 the end the following new paragraph:—

6 Maintenance men in the department of public works.

1 SECTION 2. The persons holding said positions of
2 maintenance men in the department of public works
3 on the effective date of this act may continue to serve
4 therein without examination or re-appointment.
