AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE COUNTY OF FRANKLIN TO BORROW FOR THE PURPOSE OF CONSTRUCTING THE MONTAGUE CITY BRIDGE.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. For the purpose of meeting the  
2 county's share of the cost of constructing the Montague  
3 City bridge the county treasurer, with the approval  
4 of the county commissioners, may within five years  
5 from the passage of this act borrow from time to time  
6 a sum not to exceed in the aggregate thirty thousand  
7 dollars and may issue bonds or notes of the county  
8 therefor, said bonds or notes to bear on their face the  
9 words "Franklin County Montague City Bridge Loan,  
10 Act of 1941". Each authorized issue shall constitute  
11 a separate loan and such loans shall be payable in not  
12 more than five years from their dates. Bonds or notes  
13 shall be signed by the treasurer of the county and

14 countersigned by a majority of the county commis-  
15 sioners. The county may sell said securities at public  
16 or private sale upon such terms and conditions as the  
17 county commissioners may deem proper, but not for  
18 less than their par value. Indebtedness incurred  
19 hereunder shall, except as herein provided, be subject  
20 to chapter thirty-five of the General Laws.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 acceptance during the current year by the county  
3 commissioners of the county of Franklin, but not  
4 otherwise.
