AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF WELLESLEY TO USE
FOR CERTAIN MUNICIPAL PURPOSES CERTAIN PARK
LANDS IN SAID WELLESLEY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The town of Wellesley is hereby authorized to use,
2 for the purposes of a public way to relieve traffic
3 conditions in Wellesley Hills square, so much of its
4 park lands between Worcester street and Washing-
5 ton street, adjoining the Clock Tower, formerly known
6 as Elm park, having been acquired by purchase Octo-
7 ber sixteenth, nineteen hundred and eight, from
8 Georgianna S. Livermore, as the town may by vote
9 determine.
