### AN ACT FURTHER EXTENDING THE TERM OF OFFICE OF THE MILK CONTROL BOARD.

1    *Whereas*, Under existing provisions of law the exist-  
2    ence of the milk control board will terminate on  
3    August thirty-first, nineteen hundred and forty-one,  
4    but it is necessary that the provisions of this act take  
5    effect on or before said August thirty-first, so that the  
6    existence of said board may be continued for a further  
7    period of three months without interruption; there-  
8    fore it is hereby declared to be an emergency law,  
9    necessary for the immediate preservation of the public  
10  convenience.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1    SECTION 1. Section twenty-two of chapter three  
2    hundred and seventy-six of the acts of nineteen hun-  
3    dred and thirty-four, as most recently amended by  
4    section one of chapter four hundred and eighteen of  
5    the acts of nineteen hundred and forty-one, is hereby

6 further amended by striking out, in the third line, the  
7 words "August thirty-first" and inserting in place  
8 thereof the words: — November thirtieth, — so as to  
9 read as follows: — *Section 22.* The board shall con-  
10 tinue with all the duties and responsibilities prescribed  
11 and imposed by this act until November thirtieth,  
12 nineteen hundred and forty-one. On and after the  
13 date when this act ceases to be operative any and all  
14 obligations which shall have arisen prior to such date  
15 or which may arise thereafter in connection therewith,  
16 and any violations which shall have occurred prior to  
17 such date, shall be deemed not to be affected, ter-  
18 minated or waived by reason of the fact that this act  
19 has ceased to be operative.

1 SECTION 2. The milk control board may continue  
2 expenditures in each of the months of September,  
3 October and November in the current year at the  
4 monthly rate authorized by appropriations made for  
5 the current fiscal year by items 0906-01 and 0906-02  
6 of the general appropriation act of the current year,  
7 until the general court makes an appropriation for  
8 expenditures by said board during said months of  
9 September, October and November.
