To accompany the petition of Thomas J. Lane that bowling be permitted on the Lord's Day. Mercantile Affairs.

AN ACT PERMITTING BOWLING DURING CERTAIN HOURS ON THE LORD'S DAY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter one hundred and thirty-six of the General
2 Laws is hereby amended by inserting after section
3 twenty-one, most recently amended by chapter one
4 hundred and sixty-nine of the acts of nineteen hun-
5 dred and thirty-five, the following new section:—
6 *Section 21A.* In any city or town which accepts
7 this section by vote of its city council and in any town
8 which accepts this section by vote of its inhabitants,
9 it shall be lawful to take part in or witness the game of
10 bowling on the Lord's day between the hours of one
11 and eleven post meridian, as hereinafter provided.
