To accompany the petition of John F. Manning for legislation relative to the registration of voters in the several wards of certain cities. Election Laws.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Forty-One.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE REGISTRATION OF VOTERS IN THE SEVERAL WARDS OF CERTAIN CITIES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section twenty-nine B of chapter fifty-one of the
2 General Laws, inserted therein by chapter one hun-
3 dred and seventy-nine of the acts of nineteen hundred
4 and thirty-eight, is hereby amended by inserting
5 after the word "cities" in the first line the words:—
6 of more than thirty thousand population, — so as to
7 read as follows:— *Section 29B.* In cities of more
8 than thirty thousand population the registrars shall,
9 within forty days before the biennial state election,
10 but on or before the last day fixed for registration,
11 hold one or more sessions in one or more suitable
12 places in each ward of the city.
