To accompany the petition of Walter H. Gilday and Charles G. Miles (with the approval of the mayor and city council) that certain service of Harold S. Crocker of Brockton be credited to him as a member of the contributory retirement system of said city. Pensions.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Forty-One.

AN ACT REQUIRING THAT CERTAIN SERVICE OF HAROLD S. CROCKER OF BROCKTON, NOW CITY ENGINEER OF SAID CITY, SHALL BE CREDITED TO HIM AS A MEMBER OF THE CONTRIBUTORY RETIREMENT SYSTEM OF SAID CITY AS PRIOR CREDITABLE SERVICE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The services of Harold S. Crocker of
2 Brockton, since nineteen hundred and forty city en-
3 gineer of said city, as assistant city engineer and as
4 city engineer of said city for a period of more than
5 twenty years prior to the year nineteen hundred and
6 thirty-four shall be credited to him as creditable
7 membership service in the contributory retirement
8 system of said city as if he had returned to such
9 service within the time limited by paragraph (2) of
10 section twenty-eight of chapter thirty-two of the
11 General Laws, as amended.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
