To the Honorable Senate and House of Representatives:

Under the provisions of Article LVI of the Amendments to the Constitution, I am returning herewith Senate Bill 605 entitled "An Act further regulating instruments acknowledging satisfaction of tax title accounts" with the recommendation that you amend said act by adding thereto the following:

"The delivery of such instrument shall extinguish all right and title acquired under the Collector's deed or taking".

This sentence I believe will clear up any possible ambiguity as to whether or not the cities' interest in the land has completely passed to the person who redeems the land.
