RESOLVE IN FAVOR OF CHARLES A. MERRILL & SON OF  
WINCHENDON.

1 *Resolved*, That, subject to appropriation, there be  
2 paid out of the Highway Fund to Charles A. Merrill &  
3 Son, of Winchendon, the sum of two thousand and  
4 twenty-nine dollars and sixty-six cents, being the total  
5 of compensation audit premiums on payrolls for work  
6 performed in connection with the replacement or  
7 reconstruction of the so-called Bullardville and Harris-  
8 ville bridges in said town, which were destroyed by the  
9 flood of the year nineteen hundred and thirty-eight.  
10 No payment shall be made hereunder until there shall  
11 have been filed with the comptroller an agreement  
12 signed by said Charles A. Merrill & Son, by their  
13 authorized representative, that the amount, if any,  
14 paid or to be paid for legal services rendered in con-  
15 nection with the passage of this resolve shall not ex-  
16 ceed ten per cent of said sum.
