AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE EMPLOYMENT OF VETERINARIANS BY THE DIVISION OF LIVESTOCK DISEASE CONTROL.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section six of chapter twenty of the General Laws,
2 inserted by section two of chapter three hundred
3 forty of the acts of nineteen hundred and thirty-four,
4 is hereby amended by inserting after the word
5 "require" in the fifth line the following: — ; pro-
6 vided that the employment of registered veterinarians
7 from time to time on a per diem basis shall be exempt
8 from chapter thirty-one, — so as to read as follows:
9 — *Section 6.* The director of livestock disease con-
10 trol may, subject to the approval of the commissioner,
11 appoint and remove such experts, clerical and other
12 assistants as the work of the division of livestock dis-
13 ease control may require; provided that the employ-
14 ment of registered veterinarians from time to time on
15 a per diem basis shall be exempt from chapter thirty-
16 one.
