In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Forty-Three.

AN ACT REGULATING THE PRINTING ON THE BALLOT AT STATE PRIMARIES THE NAMES OF CANDIDATES FOR NOMINATION FOR CERTAIN OFFICES BY A POLITICAL PARTY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section forty-eight of chapter fifty-three of the
2 General Laws, as most recently amended by chapter
3 six hundred and seventy-five of the acts of nineteen
4 hundred and forty-one, is hereby further amended by
5 striking out, wherever it appears, the word "resides"
6 and inserting in place thereof in each instance the
7 words: — is a registered voter.
