By Mr. Ferguson of Lexington, petition of Archibald R. Giroux and others (selectmen) that the town of Lexington be authorized to appropriate money for the removal of snow and ice from private ways open to public use. Municipal Finance (Joint).

AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE REMOVAL OF SNOW AND ICE
FROM PRIVATE WAYS OPEN TO THE PUBLIC USE IN
THE TOWN OF LEXINGTON.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The town of Lexington may appro-
2 priate money for the removal of snow and ice from
3 such private ways within its limits and open to the
4 public use as may be designated by the selectmen;
5 provided, that for the purposes of section twenty-
6 five of chapter eighty-four of the General Laws the
7 removal of snow or ice from such a way shall not
8 constitute a repair of a way.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its ac-
2 ceptance by the town of Lexington at any town meet-
3 ing of the said town pursuant to an article therefor
4 in the warrant for the said town meeting.
