

HOUSE No. 210

By Mr. Kelley of North Attleborough, petition of Francis J. Kelley for legislation relative to certain lines, poles and other equipment of the electric light department of the town of North Attleborough and of the New England Telephone and Telegraph Company in said town. Power and Light.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO CERTAIN LINES, POLES AND OTHER EQUIPMENT OF THE ELECTRIC LIGHT DEPARTMENT OF THE TOWN OF NORTH ATTLEBOROUGH, AND OF THE NEW ENGLAND TELEPHONE AND TELEGRAPH COMPANY IN SAID TOWN.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. All lines for the transmission of elec-
2 tricity for light; heat or power heretofore acquired or
3 constructed by the electric light department of the
4 town of North Attleborough, and all lines for the
5 transmission of intelligence by electricity heretofore
6 acquired or constructed by the New England Tele-
7 phone and Telegraph Company and for any other
8 telephone or telegraph company in said town, upon,
9 along, over or under the public ways and places of
10 said town, and the poles, piers, abutments, conduits

11 and other ^{or} fixtures necessary to sustain or protect the
12 wires of said lines, and in actual use on the effective
13 date of this act, are hereby made lawful notwith-
14 standing the lack of any valid locations therefor or
15 any informality in the proceedings relative to their
16 location and erection; provided, that the validation
17 aforesaid shall not be effective as to the lines, struc-
18 tures or fixtures aforesaid of such department or com-
19 pany in said town unless such department or company
20 shall, not later than December thirty-first, nineteen
21 hundred and forty-three, file with the clerk of said
22 town, a map or maps showing the location and nature
23 of the said lines, structures and fixtures in said town;
24 such map or maps to be recorded and kept with the
25 records or original locations for poles and wires in
26 said town.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
