- 3 enact such laws as may be necessary to curb the use
- 4 of the mailing privilege granted members of Congress.
- 5 *Resolved*, That copies of these Resolutions be sent
- 6 forthwith by the Secretary of the Commonwealth to
- 7 the President of the United States, to the presiding
- 8 officer of each branch of Congress and to the members
- 9 thereof from this Commonwealth.
