### AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE CONTROL OF FLAX POND IN THE CITY OF LYNN.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The city of Lynn, through its board  
2 of park commissioners, may from time to time make  
3 rules and regulations as to the erection, maintenance  
4 and control of all public bath houses on the shores of  
5 Flax pond in said city.

1 SECTION 2. The board of park commissioners of  
2 said city may from time to time make rules and regu-  
3 lations governing fishing, boating, bathing, skating  
4 and other recreational activities in or on Flax pond  
5 in said city. Such rules and regulations relative to  
6 fishing shall be subject to the approval of the division  
7 of fisheries and game of the state department of con-  
8 servation, and such other rules and regulations shall

9 be subject to the approval of the state department of  
10 public works, and when so approved shall have the  
11 force of law.

1 SECTION 3. Any police officer of said city may  
2 patrol any part of the waters of said pond and shall  
3 have authority to arrest any person violating any law  
4 of the commonwealth in, on or adjacent to the waters  
5 of said pond or violating any rule or regulation es-  
6 tablished under this act.

1 SECTION 4. The violation of any rule or regulation  
2 established under this act shall be punished by a fine  
3 of not more than twenty dollars.

1 SECTION 5. Nothing in this act shall be construed  
2 to abridge the powers and duties of said department  
3 of public works under chapter ninety-one of the Gen-  
4 eral Laws.

1 SECTION 6. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 acceptance during the current year, by vote of the  
3 city council of said city, subject to the provisions of  
4 its charter.
