AN ACT REPEALING THE LAW PROVIDING FOR EXAMINATION OF ELECTION OFFICERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

4 and forty-one, is hereby repealed.
