RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR A STUDY BY A SPECIAL COMMISSION RELATIVE TO A PEACE TIME PROGRAM OF PUBLIC WORKS AND LIKE PUBLIC UNDERTAKINGS.

1 *Resolved*, That an unpaid special commission, to
2 consist of one member of the senate to be designated
3 by the president thereof, three members of the house
4 of representatives to be designated by the speaker
5 thereof, the chairman of the public works commission
6 and the chairman of the state planning board, is
7 hereby established for the purpose of making a study
8 and formulating plans for a peace time program of
9 public works and like public undertakings, with a
10 view to furnishing employment for the men of our
11 armed forces who return from the service, together
12 with those engaged in defense industries, during the
13 time it will take to reconvert our war time industries
14 to a peace time basis.
