AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE PAYMENT OF ANNUITIES TO DEPENDENT BROTHERS AND SISTERS OF CERTAIN PUB-LIC EMPLOYEES KILLED OR DYING FROM INJURIES RECEIVED OR HAZARDS UNDERGONE IN THE PERFORMANCE OF DUTY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:
