AN ACT CHANGING THE QUALIFICATIONS OF MEMBERS OF THE BOARD OF PHARMACY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section twenty-two of chapter thirteen of the
2 General Laws is hereby amended by striking out the
3 second sentence and inserting in place thereof the
4 following:— Not more than one member shall have
5 a financial interest in the sale of drugs, medicines and
6 chemicals and the compounding and dispensing of
7 physicians' prescriptions in the same congressional
8 district.
