In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Forty-Three.

RESOLVE TO PROVIDE FOR THE PAYMENT TO HERVE TOURIGNY OF MIDDLEBORO OF WAGES AND MAINTENANCE ALLOWANCE DUE HIM AS AN EMPLOYEE OF THE COMMONWEALTH.

1 *Resolved*, That the treasurer of the commonwealth  
2 is hereby authorized and directed, upon the execution  
3 and delivery of proper receipts therefor, to pay to  
4 Herve Tourigny the sum of four hundred and eighty-  
5 one dollars and eighty cents for wages due him as an  
6 employee of the commonwealth from October nine-  
7 teenth, nineteen hundred and forty to February  
8 twenty-fifth, nineteen hundred and forty-one, and an  
9 additional sum of eighty-four dollars and thirty-three  
10 cents due him for maintenance for the same period of  
11 time.
