AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE CONTENTS OF PAY ROLLS OF
THE CITY OF BOSTON.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Chapter two hundred and ten of the
2 acts of nineteen hundred and eight is hereby amended
3 by striking out section two and inserting in place
4 thereof the following:—

5 *Section 2.* Every such pay roll, bill or account,
6 before the certificate of the civil service commission
7 or its authorized agent is affixed thereto, shall be
8 sworn to by the head of the department, or by the
9 person who is immediately responsible for the ap-
10 pointment, employment, promotion or transfer, of
11 the persons named therein, and shall contain, in
12 addition to such other information as the civil service
13 commission or its authorized agent may require, the
14 following information: First, full name of each em-

15 ployee; second, title of office or position in which
16 actually employed; third, salary, wages or other
17 compensation; fourth, dates of employment.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
