AN ACT REQUIRING THE STATE TO REIMBURSE ALL CITIES AND TOWNS FOR TUITION AND TRANSPORTATION FURNISHED TO SCHOOL CHILDREN WHOSE PARENTS ARE EMPLOYED BY THE STATE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 The state shall reimburse all cities and towns for
- 2 tuition and transportation furnished to school children
- 3 whose parents are employed by the state and who
- 4 reside on state property.
