By Mr. Walsh of Lowell, petition of George T. Walsh that the Department of Public Works be authorized to extend the Pawtucket Boulevard, so called, in the city of Lowell. Highways and Motor Vehicles.

AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE EXTENSION OF THE PAW-TUCKET BOULEVARD, SO CALLED, IN THE CITY OF LOWELL.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The department of public works is hereby author-
2 ized and directed to extend Pawtucket boulevard, so
3 called, route 113, in the city of Lowell from its exist-
4 ing easterly terminus at Mammouth road in said
5 city over Riverside street, Colonial avenue in Paw-
6 tucketville, across Beaver brook to Centerville on or
7 in rear of the Lowell flood control dikes which this
8 land is the property of the state of Massachusetts
9 or the city of Lowell, along Lakeview avenue to the
10 junction of Bridge and First streets, route 110, in
11 said city, and may expend therefor such sum, not
12 exceeding three hundred thousand dollars, as may
13 hereafter be appropriated therefor from the highway
14 fund.
