By Mr. Mahar of Orange, petition of Arthur H. MacKinnon for legislation to regulate the amount of allowance for certain members of retirement systems retired for ordinary disability. Pensions.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Forty-Three.

AN ACT REGULATING THE AMOUNT OF ALLOWANCE FOR CERTAIN MEMBERS OF RETIREMENT SYSTEMS RETIRED FOR ORDINARY DISABILITY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter thirty-two of the General
2 Laws is hereby amended in section twenty-four by
3 adding after subdivision (2) (c) the following:—
4 (3) In no case shall a member be retired under this
5 section at such annual rate of pension as would, when
6 added to his annuity, amount to a total retirement
7 allowance of less than four hundred and eighty dol-
8 lars or two thirds of his average annual compensa-
9 tion for the five years next preceding his retirement,
10 whichever is the lesser.

1 SECTION 2. Said chapter thirty-two is hereby
2 further amended in section thirty by adding after
3 subdivision (2) (c) the following:—

4 (3) In no case shall a member be retired under
5 this section at such annual rate of pension as would,
6 when added to his annuity, amount to a total retire-
7 ment allowance of less than four hundred and eighty
8 dollars or two thirds of his average annual compen-
9 sation for the five years next preceding his retirement,
10 whichever is the lesser.
