RESOLUTIONS MEMORIALIZING CONGRESS URGING THAT
THE EXPORTATION OF BUTTER FROM THIS COUNTRY BE
STOPPED.

- 1 *Resolved*, That the General Court of Massachusetts
2 urges the Congress of the United States to take im-
3 mediately such action as may be necessary to stop
4 the exportation of butter from this country in order
5 that our butter supply may be preserved for the
6 armed forces of this country and for domestic con-
7 sumption; and be it further
8 *Resolved*, That the Secretary of the Commonwealth
9 shall forthwith send certified copies of these resolu-
10 tions to the President of the United States, to the
11 presiding officer of each branch of Congress and to
12 the members of Congress from this commonwealth.
