RESOLVE AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE ARMORY
COMMISSION TO ERECT A NEW ARMORY IN THE CITY OF
CHICOPEE.

1 *Resolved*, That, after an appropriation has been
2 made, the armory commission are hereby authorized
3 and directed to erect in the city of Chicopee, at a cost
4 not exceeding dollars, on land acquired
5 or to be acquired for armory purposes under authority
6 of chapter three hundred and sixty-four of the acts
7 of nineteen hundred and thirty-six, a new armory
8 of the first class; and sections forty and forty-one of
9 chapter thirty-three of the General Laws, as appearing
10 in the Tercentenary Edition, shall, so far as appli-
11 cable, apply to proceedings taken and acts done
12 under authority of this resolve.
