AN ACT TO EXTEND THE PROVISIONS OF THE CONTRIBUTORY RETIREMENT LAW TO EMPLOYEES OF THE SALEM AND BEVERLY WATER SUPPLY BOARD.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 On July first, nineteen hundred and forty-three,
2 employees of the Salem and Beverly water supply
3 board shall be entitled to the benefits of sections
4 twenty-six to thirty-one H, inclusive, of chapter
5 thirty-two of the General Laws, and may become
6 members of the retirement system of the city of
7 Salem with all rights and obligations provided under
8 said sections in the same manner as if the retirement
9 system of the city of Salem had become operative on
10 said date.
