RESOLUTIONS ON THE DEATH OF ARTHUR E. BEANE, SPECIAL JUDGE OF PROBATE AND INSOLVENCY FOR MIDDLESEX COUNTY AND FORMER MEMBER OF THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES.

*Whereas*, The House of Representatives has learned with great sorrow of the death of Arthur E. Beane, special judge of probate and insolvency for Middlesex County for the past twenty-nine years, and a member of the House of Representatives during the years nineteen hundred and nineteen to nineteen hundred and twenty-two; therefore be it

*Resolved*, That the House of Representatives desires to express its sense of the great loss sustained by the Commonwealth in the death of such a distinguished citizen who served the Commonwealth so faithfully as a jurist and as a legislator; and be it further

*Resolved*, That the House of Representatives offers its sympathy to the family of the deceased, and directs that the Secretary of the Commonwealth submit a copy of these resolutions to them.
