### RESOLVE VALIDATING THE ACTS OF DORA MILLER AS A NOTARY PUBLIC.

1 *Resolved*, That the acts of Dora Miller of Chelsea  
2 as a notary public between August third, nineteen  
3 hundred and thirty-three and March fourth, nineteen  
4 hundred and thirty-eight, both dates inclusive, in so  
5 far as the same may have been invalid by reason of  
6 the fact that, upon the change of her name from Dora  
7 Ginsberg, she failed to re-register under her new name  
8 and pay to the state secretary a fee of one dollar as  
9 required by section thirteen of chapter thirty of the  
10 General Laws, are hereby confirmed and made valid.
