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To accompany the petition of Esther G. Drummey that provision be made for the payment of a sum of money to William W. Drummey for services rendered in connection with work performed on certain property of the Commonwealth. Ways and Means.

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## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Forty-Three.

### RESOLVE IN FAVOR OF WILLIAM W. DRUMMEY.

1    *Resolved*, That for the purpose of discharging a moral  
2 obligation of the commonwealth and for the purpose  
3 of promoting the public good, there be paid from the  
4 state treasury, out of the money appropriated by item  
5 one hundred and thirty-one A of section two of chap-  
6 ter five hundred and seven of the acts of nineteen  
7 hundred and thirty-eight, to William W. Drummey  
8 of Boston, the sum of three hundred and fifty-seven  
9 dollars and thirty-four cents, being the amount deter-  
10 mined to be due said Drummey under the terms of a  
11 certain authorization or of an agreement between the  
12 commonwealth and him for services rendered in con-  
13 nection with work performed on certain property of  
14 the commonwealth made necessary by the hurricane  
15 and floods of September, nineteen hundred and thirty-  
16 eight. No payment shall be made hereunder until  
17 said Drummey shall have signed and filed with the  
18 comptroller an agreement that the amount, if any,  
19 paid or to be paid for legal services rendered in con-  
20 nection with the passage of this resolve shall not

21 exceed ten per cent of the sum payable hereunder,  
22 nor until said Drummey shall execute and file with  
23 the comptroller a release, satisfactory in form to the  
24 attorney general, in full satisfaction of all claims  
25 asserted by him for compensation for services under  
26 said authorization or agreement, whether or not legal  
27 proceedings therefor are pending upon the effective  
28 date of this resolve.
