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To accompany the petition of Maurice M. Goldman for legislation to provide for the ownership and control of certain records and other documents upon the termination of a contract of agency between an insurance company and an agent. Insurance.

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## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

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In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Forty-Three.

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AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR THE OWNERSHIP AND CONTROL OF CERTAIN RECORDS AND OTHER DOCUMENTS UPON THE TERMINATION OF A CONTRACT OF AGENCY BETWEEN AN INSURANCE COMPANY AND AN AGENT.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter one hundred and seventy-five of the Gen-  
2 eral Laws is hereby amended by inserting after section  
3 one hundred and sixty-four A, inserted by chapter two  
4 hundred and twenty-five of the acts of nineteen hun-  
5 dred and thirty-eight, the following section: —  
6 *Section 164B.* Upon the termination of any agency  
7 agreement or contract, the records and the right to use  
8 and the control of expirations shall be and remain the  
9 property of the agent provided that he has accounted  
10 for and paid to the company all sums due by him. If  
11 the agent is indebted to the company upon such ter-  
12 mination such records shall be the property of the  
13 company.
