To accompany the petition of Eugene H. Giroux for the payment by the Commonwealth of an annuity to Marion R. Pickett, widow of John Pickett, a former employee of the Department of Public Works. Pensions.

RESOLVE IN FAVOR OF MARION R. PICKETT OF SOMERVILLE.

1 *Resolved*, That for the purpose of discharging a moral
2 obligation of the commonwealth, there be allowed
3 and paid out of the state treasury to Marion R.
4 Pickett, widow of John Pickett, formerly an employee
5 of the department of public works, who was killed
6 while in the performance of his duties at Reading on
7 July sixth, nineteen hundred and thirty-six, an an-
8 nuity of dollars for the benefit of herself
9 and her minor children, payable in equal monthly
10 instalments, for a period of years, com-
11 mencing June first, nineteen hundred and forty-three.
12 No payment shall be made hereunder until there has
13 been filed with the comptroller an agreement signed
14 by said Marion R. Pickett that the amount, if any,
15 paid or to be paid for legal services rendered in con-
16 nection with the passage of this resolve shall not ex-
17 ceed ten per cent of the maximum amount payable
18 hereunder.
